

# POLART SYDNEY 2022 – EXHIBITION APPLICATION

## “POLISH TIES” YOUTH EXHIBITION (UNDER 18)

Please read the entire form and all its terms and conditions before completing the exhibition application form. Submission of an artwork does not automatically result in acceptance for the PolArt Sydney 2022 festival, it submits an application for consideration by PolArt Sydney 2022 Inc. This form must be completed by a parent or legal guardian of the child that creates the artwork. The form refers to the parent or legal guardian as “applicant” and the child as “entrant”.

### Terms & Conditions for Artwork Consideration - Entrants

- Entrants must be under 18 years of age and must remain under 18 years of age until 7 January 2023.
- The PolArt Sydney 2022 Inc visual art youth exhibition program is open to Australian and New Zealand residents whose submitted works draw directly from Polish culture.
- Applications must be completed and agreed by the entrant’s parent or legal guardian (the applicant).

### Terms & Conditions for Artwork Consideration - Eligible Work

- Artworks must be submitted with agreement that ownership of the work is being granted to PolArt Sydney 2022. Artworks will not be returned to entrants.
- Drawing, watercolour, painting, printmaking, illustrations, photography, graphic design, printed digital art, are accepted.
- Artworks must be 210mm x 297mm (A4) on paper.
- Artworks must not be framed or mounted in any fashion, artworks are to be just a single sheet of A4 paper.
- Artworks must not be folded.
- Artworks must be clearly marked with pencil on the back of the artwork with the artist’s full name and the title of the work.
- Artworks must be created by the entrant after 1 December 2021.
- The artworks must be visibly related to the theme of “a Polish tapestry through time” and to Polish culture.
- The artworks must not be offensive, defamatory, discriminatory, harassing or graphically disturbing.
- The artworks must not be polarising politically, ideologically or socially.

### Terms & Conditions - Application Process

- Applications must be received prior to 31 October 2022.
- Incomplete application forms will not be considered.
- Applications submitted without an artwork will not be considered.
- An applicant may be required to provide additional information in connection with an application or a work submitted. Failure to provide the additional information may result in rejection of the application.
- Submission of an application form does not constitute any agreement from PolArt Sydney 2022 Inc to list works in the visual arts exhibition program. The application form will be reviewed by the Selection Panel.
- The Selection Panel will be comprised of arts industry professionals within PolArt Sydney 2022 Inc. This Selection Panel will review and assess all applications received and will select the works to be exhibited.
- Works will be primarily selected based on compliance with the entry criteria but the Selection Panel will use its discretion in assessing suitability of entries.
- The Selection Panel’s decision is final, and no correspondence will be exchanged regarding rejection of any works.

### Artwork Documentation, Photography, and Intellectual Property

- The applicant warrants that all work submitted is the original work of the entrant and does not infringe the copyright, moral rights, or other rights of any third party. The applicant indemnifies PolArt Sydney 2022 against any actions brought about by third parties claiming infringement of any copyright, moral or any other rights.
- PolArt Sydney 2022 acknowledges that copyright remains with the artist.
- The applicant agrees that PolArt Sydney 2022 may promote the artwork on any internal and external websites, social media channels and any promotional material whether physical or digital.
- The applicant agrees that PolArt Sydney 2022 may exhibit the artwork.
- The applicant grants permission to PolArt Sydney 2022 Inc, to PolArt Inc and/or their agents to publish any material submitted, as well as any material containing their artwork to promote PolArt Sydney 2022 Inc festival and any lead up events or future activities of PolArt Inc and its subsidiaries and licensees. The applicant agrees that this permission extends to promotion of future festivals operated by or under the direction of PolArt Inc.

### Force Majeure

- Where, for any reason beyond the reasonable control of PolArt Sydney 2022 Inc including, for example, earthquake; flood; fire; act of God; terrorism; pandemic; government directions, orders or regulations; labour strikes or other emergency event, PolArt Sydney 2022 Inc is prevented or materially hindered from holding an exhibition of works at the exhibition space then it may vary, postpone or cancel the event by notice in writing to that effect to the artists and by a notice on its website.
